FUNDRAISING IDEAS

THANK YOU for registering for the 'ADS' Santa Fun Run event to help us raising funds for Alzheimers Dementia Support 'ADS' Charity to enable them to help People whose lives are affected by Dementia directly or indirectly.

Here are some fundraising ideas that we propose you consider. Not all of them are related to running, but they all have the same purpose: increase awareness of our Charity and help us raising funds for our cause.

Whilst you can use our Sponsorship Forms, please take into consideration setting up your own JustGiving page as this is the easiest and safe way to collect money for our Charity.

JustGiving

Set up your fundraising as a competition between classes or year groups. The winners will beneficiate from the prize (eg. a day trip).

Challenge your pupils to walk/run 5k on your own grounds or in a local area. Host a fundraising themed quiz and charge for entry. It can be organised during different classes (eg. during the History class, they would have a 15-min quiz and the winner gets a free pass from homeworks).

Organise a Sports Day full of competitions for all year groups and ask for a donation to participate. You could also sell tickets for the spectators (eg. parents). Set up a donation station and run it for a longer period of time so that everybody can donate special items for our Charity Shop. We can also provide you with a collection box. We will collect everything from you at the end of your event.

Hold a Christmas decorations sale. Pupils can even craft them during the creative classes.

Have a "Movie Day". Play documentaries and charge for entry. Pupils can volunteer to bring homemade snacks (eg. popcorn) for sale. Allow the pupils to pay a minimum price for not wearing the uniform for 1 day.

Set up "Santa's trail" - a treasure hunt on your own grounds or somewhere local. Ask for a donation to participate. You can make teams so it gets more competitive. Have a fun day with all kinds of competitions, games and raffles. You can charge for entry, raffle tickets and so on.

While we encourage you to choose one or more ideas from above, you can always organise whatever kind of activity you feel is more appropriate for your school.

Please remember that we provide you FREE medals and Certificates for each participant in exchange for a voluntary donation of £2.50.
